- Provide universal access and visibility to consistent, real-time information across the enterprise



U.S. AIR FORCE

Project: Engineering and Technology Acquisition Support Services Follow-on (ETASS II)

- **Objective:** Execute re-competition of existing ETASS I contract
 - **Scope:** ESC-wide A&AS support for engineering and technical services
 - **Acquisition Approach:** Small business set aside. IDIQ Ordering Period will consist of a 3-year base and two 1-year options. TOs not to exceed 3-years with a 1-year base and two 1-year options. CPFF contract type.
 - **Timeframe:** Contract award tentatively scheduled for Nov 2012
 - **Dollar Value:** ~\$6.5M at ESC level, Division level Task Oder PWS will be posted on HERBB at a later date - <http://herbb.hanscom.af.mil/>
- **RFP:** 30 Jun 2011



Upcoming Acquisitions

U.S. AIR FORCE

Project: Professional Acquisition Support Services Follow-on (PASS II)

- **Objective:** Execute re-competition of existing PASS I contract
- **Scope:** ESC-wide A&AS support for program/acquisition management services
- **Acquisition Approach:** 1-year CPFF bridge contract followed by a multiple award IDIQ (to Small Business) with a 5-year ordering period; Task orders limited to 1-year basic, with 2, 1-year options.
- **Timeframe:** IDIQ source selection ~Mar – Sep 2012
IDIQ Contract Award ~26 Nov 2012 / Task Order Awards ~Dec 2012 – Feb 2013
- **Dollar Value:** ~\$864M at ESC level, Division level Task Order

Project: Business Operations Support Services

- **Objective:** Award a directed 8(a) contract
- **Scope:** A&AS support for program administrative support
- **Acquisition Approach:** Directed 8(a) Set-Aside
- **Timeframe:** Anticipated award date Oct 2011
- **Dollar Value:** Less than \$4M



How Industry Can Help

U.S. AIR FORCE

- Future Air Force acquisition approach broadens Program Office responsibility for delivery of Enterprise Business System capability
- Government role to now include COTS ERP implementation vs. pure acquisition role. Execution responsibility focused on:
 - Architecture & Design
 - Development of Solution (Configuration, RICE, Data Preparation)
 - Training Material and Delivery Techniques
 - Testing
 - Fielding
 - Environment and Infrastructure Management
 - Organizational Change Management
- To make transition successful Air Force will need to:
 - Leverage industry knowledge base to implement industry best practices and tools
 - Augment Program Office resources with industry ERP Product and Professional expertise
