Goals


- **Deliver capabilities on time, on target, and within budget**

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Project: LOGFAC

- **Objective:** LOGFAC is a Web-enabled application developed to support Operations and Logistics planning staffs at the Headquarters (HQ) Air Staff, Major Command (MAJCOM), Air Component, and Unit levels.
- **Scope:** Software Development, Test and Field Support, LOGFAC 3.0 Integration, Help Desk, Sustainment, and Transition
- **Acquisition Approach:** NETCENTS 1 Task Order
- **Timeframe:** Dec 2011 – Jan 2014
- **Dollar Value:** \$7.7M

- **RFP:** November 2011
- **POC:** Mrs. Janice Woodson, Ms. Kameke Mitchell, Lt Rob Mobley



Upcoming Acquisitions

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Project: DCAPEs INCREMENT 2B

- **Objective:** Develop and deliver capabilities from JROC approved CDD; maintain interoperability with key interface partners (JOPES)
- **Scope:** Software Development, Test, and Field Support, Help Desk Support; Interoperability and Sustainment, and Transition for both DCAPEs and LOGFAC
- **Acquisition Approach:** Full & Open Competition
- **Timeframe:** Jan 2013 – Jan 2018
- **Dollar Value:** \$70M
- **RFP:** Draft RFP Target: Jan 2012/Final RFP Release: Mar 2012
- **POC:** Mrs. Janice Woodson, Ms. Debra Foster, Mr. Kevin Lee



Upcoming Acquisitions

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Project: ACES, IWIMS, FD & EODIMS

- **Objective:** Provide extensive data management capabilities to assist the Civil Engineer in real property, readiness, work control, asset and financial management, fire operations, and EOD functions
- **Scope:** Provide limited 24x7 level 1 (Phone), level 2 (Functional), & level 3 (Programmatic) help desk support; Ensure systems remain compliant with regulatory and law changes; Provide sustainment and minor upgrades to systems; Support data calls; Provide data integration support to the NexGen PMO
- **Acquisition Approach:** NETCENTS I Task Order
- **Timeframe:** 1 May 2012 – 30 Apr 2013
- **Dollar Value:** ~\$4M
- **RFP:** Feb 2012
- **POC:** Mrs. LaShunya Johnson-Vinson, Ms. Penny Connerley, and Mr. Roger Zinke
