John Hulsey is the Deputy Directory, Logistics and Maintenance Systems Division, Business Information System Directorate, Maxwell Air Force Base, Gunter Annex, Alabama. His organization is responsible for the maintenance and sustainment of 96 Logistics and Maintenance Information Technology systems. He directs over 500 personnel located at 2 CONUS and 1 OCONUS locations. His systems support over 200,000 USAF, US Army, DoD, and NATO users at 500 sites worldwide in the execution of their mission. He is directly responsible for the annual delivery of over 200 software solutions, execution of a \$230M+ annual budget, 33 support and sustainment contracts. He is also the System Sustainment Manager for the

Expeditionary Combat Support System—a large Enterprise Resource Planning (ERP) system that will merge base level and wholesale AF logistics systems.

Mr. Hulsey was born in Gainesville, Georgia. He received a Bachelor of Business Administration in Management Information Systems from the University of Georgia in 1987. Upon his college graduation, he entered federal civil service—beginning his career as a Palace Acquire management trainee, a 3 year management training program, with the Headquarters Standard Systems Group at Gunter AFB, Alabama.
