

Ms Denise Baylor is the Director of Small Business Programs for the Air Force Program Executive Officer for Business and Enterprise Systems (AFPEO BES) at Maxwell Air Force Base-Gunter Annex, Montgomery, Alabama. She advises and supports contracting officers, program managers, and requirements personnel on all matters that affect small businesses, historically black colleges and universities or minority institutions, and labor surplus area concerns.
