

Mr. Wendell L. Quinton serves as a Supervisor in the Financial Enterprise Systems Branch for Budget, Accounting and Decision Support systems with a total contract value exceeding \$100M. He has more than 33 years of experience across a spectrum of managerial and technical disciplines in the government and military. He completed a year of Education with Industry, where he implemented a Commercial Off The Shelf (COTS) solution to bring the National Cash Register Company into compliance with the Sarbanes–Oxley Act of 2002. Before assuming his current position, he was the Program Manager for the Financial Information Resource System.

Mr. Quinton held military and civilian positions with the U. S. Navy from November 1978 until September 1988. He was a U.S Navy Radioman, with two deployments to the Persian Gulf where his team's mission was to relay Iranian and Iraqi troop movements to the Carrier Task Force. As a civilian, he served as a communications operator for the Naval Education Training Center, Newport RI and the Automated Digital Network Switching Center at Albany GA.

From there, he moved to Dayton OH, establishing the first ever Communications Office for the Headquarters, Air Force Logistics Command, Intelligence Directorate. He continues to serve the renamed organization in his current capacity.
