- Transforms FM processes & systems at USTRANSCOM, DFAS, and USAF - Key part of USAF solution for 2017 auditability requirements of FY10 NDAA
- Completed roll-out to four MAJCOMS (AMC, ACC, AFGSC, AETC) = 6900 users/42 sites
- Jun 15 deployment to 11 AF Reserve Command and 32 Air National Guard sites (2,300 new users)
- Full implementation by Oct 16 will add AFMC, AFSPC, PACAF, and USAFE (total users ~23K)
- 1.7M transactions processed through DEAMS in Mar 15
- As of Feb 15, bases with DEAMS users manage \$52B Air Force Budget Authority
- Milestone Decision Authority issued Acquisition Decision Memorandum approving MS C 23 Feb 15
- SAF/FM declared Initial Operational Capability (IOC) on 6 May 15
- AFOTEC conducting Initial Operational Test and Evaluation—Report expected in 4Qtr FY15

# Air Force Equipment Management System (AFEMS)



## Description

- AFEMS is a United States Air Force (USAF) automated system that is used to manage all equipment at retail and wholesale levels throughout the USAF to meet peacetime and wartime mission requirements. Loss of system will cause an eventual stoppage of direct mission support of wartime or contingency operations.
- AFEMS provides worldwide visibility of equipment and Information Technology (IT) assets. This includes current authorizations, forecasted authorizations, in-use assets, and in-place assets.

# Requirements Management System (RMS) and Logistics Management Data Bank (LMDB)



## Description

The **scope** of this contract covers all tasks necessary to provide system sustainment, maintenance, and modification of the RMS and LMDB systems.
