Project Name: Requirements Management System and Logistics Management Data Bank Systems (RMS and LMDB)

Program Description: RMS is a suite of 11 subsystems supporting a set of logistics processes and models integrated by a relational database. This system automates and integrates the AF materiel requirements determination processes which compute procurement, termination and repair requirements for spares, repair parts, and major equipment items for logistics support of weapons systems. Data from the requirements process is stratified to project fiscal budget requirements.

LMDB system provides analysis support to the Air Logistics Complexes, HQ AFMC and has 2 components. The Automated Budget Compilation System (ABCS) supports budget information, depot maintenance workload planning, tracking of on order excess, and Performance Based Logistics contractual requirements definition for weapons systems. The Logistics Reassignment (LR) system generates cataloging transactions required to transfer selected items to the Defense Logistics Agency.

Objective: This effort is to acquire sustainment and maintenance support for RMS and LMDB

Program Description: Air Force, Army, Navy, Marine Corps, and National Security Agency transportation activities use CMOS to automate and streamline base level cargo movement processes and support rapid movement of joint military capability anywhere in the world under any conditions. Project Name: System Metric and Reporting Tool (SMART)/Acquisition Workbench (AcqWB)

Program Description: SMART/AcqWB enables program managers to perform standardized day-to-day lifecycle management of acquisition programs with reporting as a by-product for well-informed decisions from OSD and Air Force senior leadership.

Objective: Provide sustainment, maintenance, and modifications to the System Metric and Reporting Tool (SMART) Acquisition Workbench (AcqWB).

Scope: The scope of this effort is to continue the status reporting initiative that granted access to key program parameters rather than having program and project office personnel generate status reports, coordinate those reports through the chain of command, and provide the coordinated reports to decision makers. The current effort is being developed using the incremental development paradigm, generating requirements that are satisfied in rapidly developed tool releases. Two major versions are generally planned for release per year, broken down into 1-2 agile production releases per month due to new/updated staff policy, technical insertion, system infrastructure and/or security compatibility, or high risk deficiencies. These versions are being developed using Microsoft SharePoint 2010, Microsoft “.NET” C#, Team Foundation Server, SQL Server Business Intelligence Tools, Nintex workflow, Public Key Infrastructure and Security Token Service authentication/authorization, SQL Server, AJAX, and web services. Familiarity with these capabilities and how they can be applied to a Service Oriented Architecture (SOA) environment hosted on the DISA Defense Enterprise Portal Service (DEPS) and MilCloud Platform as a Service (PaaS) is a firm requirement. Support for the engineering and development of other AcqDOM-related capabilities outside of SMART (but interoperable with SMART) may be prioritized and scoped for work.

Program Description: The Aviation Resource Management System (ARMS) is the Air Force authoritative system for over 63,000 frontline aviators and parachutists, recording and calculating aircrew training information such as due dates, frequency, and accomplishments for all training events. ARMS provides AFI-mandated aviation qualifications and training requirements, safety of flight currency requirements, go/no-go qualifications, individual flying hour tracking, aircrew experience level tracking, aeronautical order management and career flying gates, and incentive pay tracking. The Air Force uses this information to enhance the safety-of-flight operations and determine whom to select for specific missions. ARMS is the cornerstone data source for individual and unit readiness.

Project Name: Enterprise Environmental Safety and Occupational Health Management Information System (EESOH-MIS)

Program Description: EESOH-MIS is a joint comprehensive, automated information system for assembling, comparing, using, evaluating, and storing environmental and civil engineering information, engineering control, hazardous material inventory and usage data, regulatory compliance and work practice procedures, hazardous waste tracking, pollution prevention, and restoration and cleanup.
