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

**Program Description:** IMDS CDB is the Enterprise Combat Air Forces Field Maintenance System. MSAT is a base level program that schedulers at all levels use to ensure the fleet is safe to fly and that resources are available to meet assigned missions.

**Project Name:** Global Force Management – Data Initiative (GFM-DI) Air Force Organizational Server (AFOS) Increment 2 Development & Sustainment

**Program Description:** The GFM-DI is a Joint Staff and OSD initiative to standardize force structure data representation, making it visible, accessible, and understandable across the DoD. The AFOS consumes data from various Air Force Authoritative Data Sources, validates it, formats it in a consistent force structure data standard, and publishes it for consumption by programs of record that use force structure data for war and contingency planning, by providing visibility of the entire force structure as a function of time: past, present and future.


