

LAURENCE “LARRY” McGRAW

Laurence “Larry” McGraw is the Chief, Portfolio Management, Business and Enterprise Systems (BES) Directorate, Maxwell AFB-Gunter Annex, Alabama. He leads support for over 120 Information Technology Business Systems with an annual budget of over \$1.1B. He directs a team of 14, conducting program control, portfolio management, and strategic communications supporting 1800 military, civilian, and contractor personnel. Interfacing regularly with SAF/AQ, AFMC, LCMC, General Officers and Senior Executive Service members, he plans, organizes, directs, and controls regular program reviews, status, and programmatic metrics for the directorate portfolio, along with strategic communications to government and industry partners.



Mr. McGraw enlisted in the Air Force as an Avionics Systems Specialist in 1984 and was commissioned through Officer Training School in 1999. During his career, he performed, supervised, and instructed avionics maintenance on numerous aircraft including A-10, F-16, B-1, and F-117 platforms. He deployed in support of Operation Desert Storm in 1993, leading an avionics and sensors team maintaining mission readiness of the F-117 Nighthawk. As a commissioned officer, he served as a Deputy and Launch Crew Commander on several Defense Meteorological Satellite Program and National Recognizance Office missions from Vandenberg AFB, California. Later, Mr. McGraw served as a Deputy Program Manager for Air Combat Command Ranges, Cargo Movement Operations System Program Manager, and Director, Plans and Programs before retiring in 2008. He entered civil service in 2008 as a Program Manager and served as Transportation Branch Chief in the Logistics Systems Division of the Enterprise Logistics Systems Directorate before assuming his current duties in January 2012. Mr. McGraw is a Program Management Level III Certified Acquisition Professional.
